

ELIGIBILITY

Any female artist that is a member of the Women's Art Club of Hamilton (WACH) is eligible to participate. The show is open to all media: ceramic, mosaic, glass, fiber, paintings, drawings, jewelry, photography, glass fusing, enameling, sculpture, printmaking, mixed media, and art installations (within space limitations). All entries must be the original work of the submitting artist. The WACH reserves the right to reject works that we deem inappropriate for our audience or that do not meet the standards of quality or preparation for display outlined in these guidelines.

INSTALLATION REQUIREMENTS

All 2D & 3D fine art and fine craft media are acceptable. Works cannot have been previously exhibited at Fitton Center or The Strauss Gallery. The Fitton Center's walls are fabric-covered with a 3/4-inch plywood interior that can hold weight with nail based hardware (the wall can't accept screws). Works must be completely dry, clean, and ready to install with hanging or display devices that are appropriate to the piece. Works on paper must be framed or otherwise protected. Canvases must be wired for hanging. Canvases must be framed or the sides painted. Quilts or other fiber works must include a hanging sleeve and wooden slat so that the piece may be attached to the fabric wall with nails. No tape or saw tooth hangers permitted. Neither 2D nor 3D submissions can be greater than 48" in any direction. Special installation needs should be noted on the application (electricity, suspension, unusual hanging methods, or hardware). Extremely lightweight works can be suspended from the ceiling. Art should weigh no more than 100 lbs. and be appropriate for a high foot traffic/hallway space. WACH and Fitton Center and their representatives will not be held responsible for failure of hanging hardware or methods provided by the artist.

ENTRY FEES

There is a \$35 non-refundable entry fee for all members of WACH. Payment to be made electronically by credit card when completing application. A maximum of 3 entries can be submitted per artist. Works need not be for sale to be included.

SALES

Artists will receive 65% of their listed retail price for artworks sold during the exhibition. All published pricing of exhibited artwork will be determined directly from the entry form. Prices may not be changed during the coordination or run of this exhibition. If no sale price is provided by the entrant, it will be documented as not for sale (NFS). Works need not be for sale to be included and may be marked as NFS on the entry form. Sold artwork will be released at the end of the show.

LIABILITY/AGREEMENT

All reasonable care will be taken in handling submitted work. Each work is insured to a reasonable extent while on Fitton premises. Artists are responsible for insuring works while in transit. The artist gives her permission to allow WACH and Fitton Center to photograph and otherwise reproduce her artwork in print, electronic, or other media without compensation for advertising purposes. Show participants agree to all conditions herein.

SPECIAL NOTES

Artists are responsible for delivering artwork to Fitton Center. Artists may give others permission to drop off or pick up artwork at their discretion. Designees will need to sign for the artwork when transporting for the artists.

This is a curated show. Not all artworks submitted will be exhibited. Artwork selected will be announced on or before January 25, 2026.

This is a juried show. Jury awards will be announced at the Gallery Opening. A People's Choice Award will be announced online March 6.
